



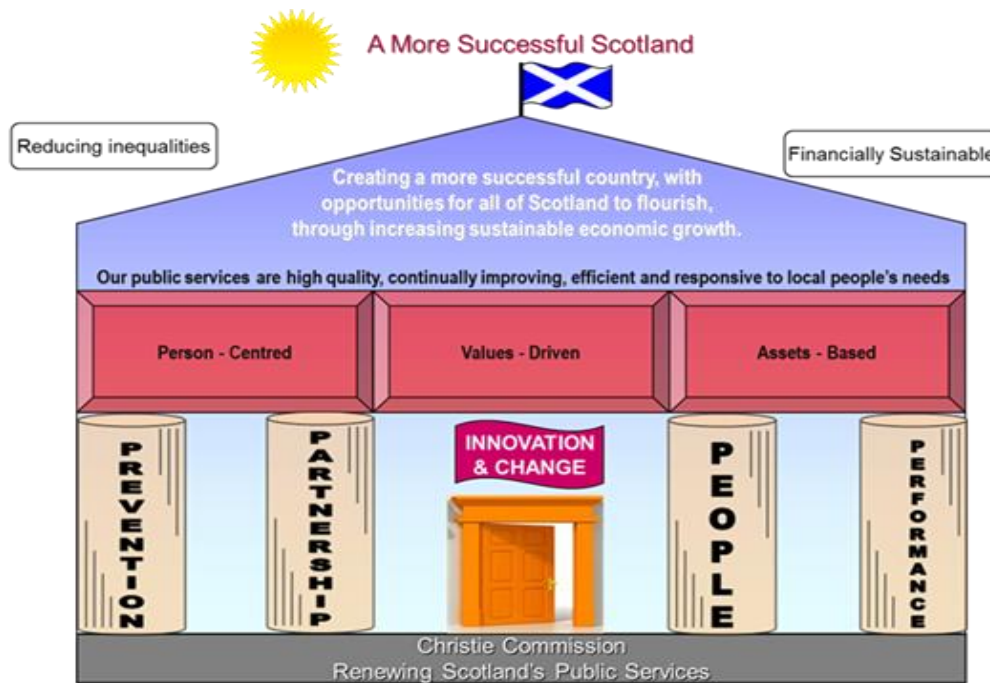

Legislative Context



What has happened so far?

April 2013, members of Fife Council's Executive Committee and NHS Fife Board jointly agreed the following:

- a Shadow Integrated Health and Social Care Partnership Board was established in June 2013 to lead the changes so that Fife is ready for Scottish Government legislation in 2014.
- the appointment of Stephen Moore (Executive Director of Social Work and Lead for Health) as Interim Director of Health and Social Care. He took up post on 1 May 2013.
- a work plan to progress their priorities including the Integration Plan and Joint Strategic Commissioning Plan.



Working Groups

The Shadow Board Work plan is being taken forward on a series of themes, including:

- Integrated budgets and financial planning
- Communications
- Workforce and HR implications
- Governance and Accountability
- Joint Commissioning Strategy



Health & Social Care Integration

In April this Year became an Act. It is now formally referred to as the Public Bodies (Joint Working)(Scotland) Act 2014.

Draft Regulations and Orders in relation to the Act are now out for consultation

- Re-ablement, telecare



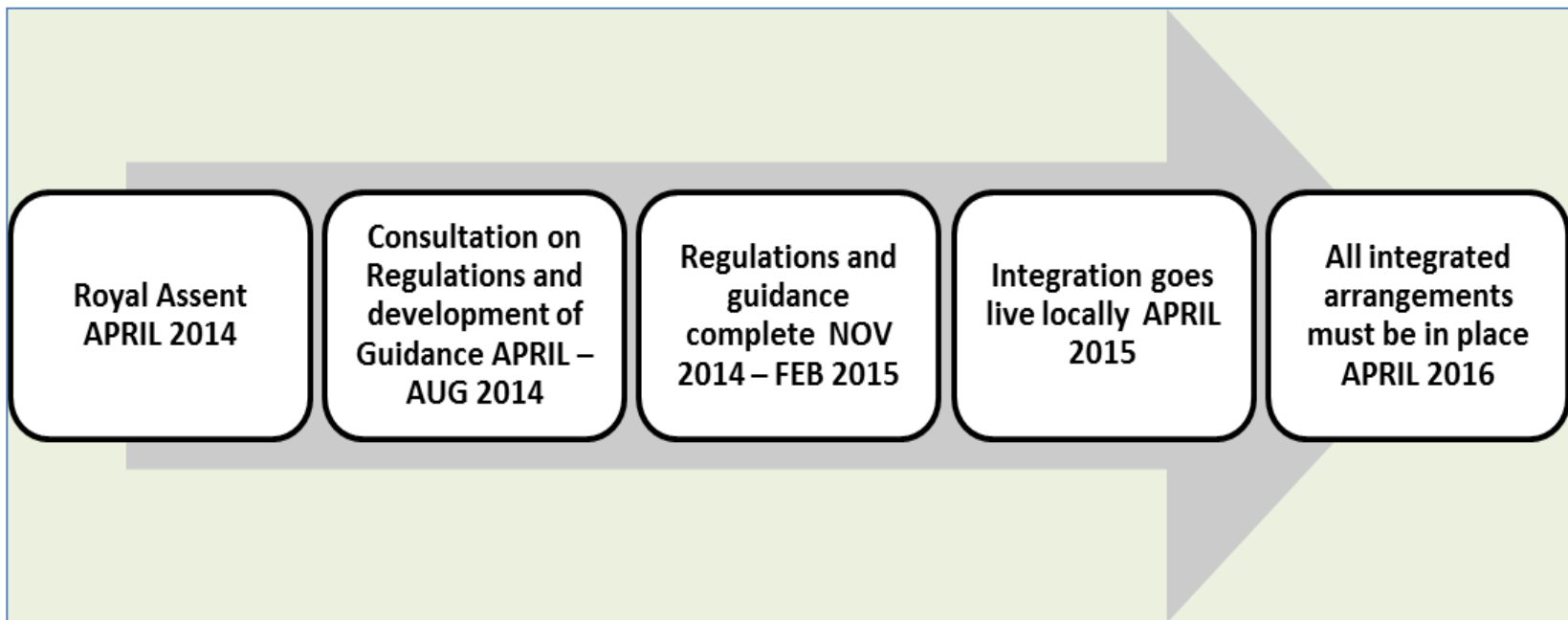
