

Do you have experience of taking Sodium Valproate?

Healthcare Improvement Scotland would like to speak to people about their experience of **taking the medication Valproate**.

Medication that contains Valproate could include Belvo, Convulex, Depakote, Dyzantil, Epilim, Epilim Chrono or Chronosphere, Episenta, Epival, and Syonell.

We are looking to speak with people who are:

Currently taking Valproate <u>or</u> have stopped taking Valproate since August 2023

and

- women and men who are able to become pregnant, or get someone pregnant, if they are not on contraception
- are aged between 12 55 years old

We **also would like to speak to carers** of people with the above characteristics

This work will inform NHS Boards' plans for the safe use of Valproate. This will ensure person-centred, safe, and effective implementation of new measures.
